All materials excluding your track and fabric are included in the price.

Please read the guide attached on the Workshop details page on how to measure your window for a blind. If we do not receive your required track measurement then we will simply provide you with a standard size track.

Please note your track <u>can not</u> be cut down on the day. Payment for your track will be requested at least 1 week prior to the class date to allow the track to be ordered.

We have our fabric shop on site with hundreds of rolls of suitable blind fabric on the roll, all at reduced prices, and we have a wide range of remnants suitable for these smaller projects.

With the ever growing threat from online retailers we humbly ask all our students to consider sourcing their fabric from our beautiful little shop if at all possible. If you have a specific fabric in mind then we can likely order this for you in advance of your class.
